The Child Advocate Cassandra Sanchez and Assistant Child Advocate Jennifer Jones embarked on a two day trip to visit residentially placed young people. The first day, they visited with many of the young women who live at the Vermont Permanency Initiative (VPI). VPI's mission is to provide a therapeutic community that enables youth to heal from past trauma, find pleasure and joy in their present lives and build resources for their futures. The kids shared that the greenhouse was a favorite spot and Jennifer noted that the housing spaces are well laid out and spacious.
